CHILD & YOUTH PROGRAMS









CHILD DEVELOPMENT HOME: (904) 542-5381

The Child Development Home (CDH) program is an extension of the Child Development Center (CDC) program located in Bldg. 2070. These homes are independent business enterprises operated by Navy certified military family members in their own homes.

The CDH program has an open door policy and allows young children to receive the same early start in learning just as the CDC provides, but in a home-like environment while providing continued support to parents and military readiness. Providers may live either on or off base and may care for up to six children (including their own) under the age of eight. Some providers operate infant-only homes, allowing a provider to care for only three children under the age of 24 months (including their own children). Providers must maintain current CPR and First Aid Certification, maintain current liability insurance and pass monthly inspections by the CDH Program Director/Monitor. They also prepare meals in accordance with the USDA Food Program guidelines. Providers receive continuous monthly trainings on age appropriate activities for young children and professional ethics. The Commanding Officer has the final authority to certify all homes enrolled in the program.

A subsidy program is available to provide weekly rates that are similar to those of the CDC for children 6 weeks to 12 years of age. Subsidy rates are available to parents that have been referred to CDH providers from the MilitaryChildCare.com waitlist. The CDH program offers full day, hourly, drop-in, before and after school, special needs, weekend and night care. All rates are determined by total family income.

CHILD DEVELOPMENT CENTER: (904) 542-5529

The Child Development (CDC) program provides full-time and drop-in care. The CDC is a full-time care facility that comprises the majority of care provided and it includes breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack. The fee structure for full-time care is based on total family income as regulated by Department of Defense instructions. Hourly or drop-in care is limited due to space availability. Reservations are required and can be made up to 30 days in advance. Hourly care is available for ages 6 weeks - 5 years based on availability. Priority for full-time care is given to single and dual military families.

This program is based on the National Association for the Education of Young Children's guidelines on Developmentally Appropriate Practice in Early Childhood Programs and strives to promote the physical, social, emotional, and cognitive development of children, while responding to the needs of the family. Activities children have the opportunity to participate in include: creative art, music, fine and gross motor skills development, sand and water play, songs and finger play, story times, readiness skills for math, reading and writing, dramatic play and activities to promote positive social skills and self-image. Children have free choice in selecting activities. Children will be involved in "play" and will learn the following: selecting, experimenting, classifying, measuring, discussing, validating, enjoying, participating, testing, questioning, organizing, observing, improving, discovering and constructing.

YOUTH ACTIVITIES & PROGRAMS: (904) 778-9772

Located in Bldg. 2069 on Mustin Road, the base youth program consists of many different activities to accommodate military and DoD dependents kindergarten through 18 years of age. Programs and special events offered to military children through the year include Month of the Military Child activities, Military Family Appreciation Festival, National Night Out, 4-H, Anchor4Life, fitness programs and much more!

SCHOOL-AGE CARE PROGRAM: (904) 778-9772

The School-Age Care program is available for dependents of military and DoD personnel for children kindergarten through 12 years of age. Trained counselors help children with homework, arts and crafts and other activities. All counselors have experience in childhood education and are CPR and First Aid Certified.

SCHOOL LIAISON OFFICE: (904) 778-2236

Located close to base housing in Bldg. 2065 on Mustin Road, the School Liaison Officer (SLO) serves as the primary link between schools, Commanders and military parents pertaining to K-12 educational issues. The job of the SLO is to inform and link military families to the resources and information needed to maximize the educational opportunities to ensure academic success for all military children.

CAMPS: (904) 778-9772

Spring Break Day Camp, Summer Day Camp and Holiday Camp are three of the many programs provided by the Youth Activities Center. Summer Camp runs for 10 weeks and includes swimming, arts and crafts, nature hikes, bowling and various field trips. Camp is 5 a.m. – 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.

FITNESS, SPORTS & AQUATICS







BASE GYM: (904) 542-2930

Located in Bldg. 614 on Gillis Street, the gym offers strength and cardiovascular fitness equipment. There are two weight rooms and one cardio only room. The strength rooms are complete with Hammer Strength weights, Free Motion Cable machines, dumbbells and benches. Also available are male and female steam and sauna rooms. The facility includes one indoor basketball court, two racquetball courts and two high performance rooms. Athletic gear is available, such as softball kits, cones, frisbees and other miscellaneous sports equipment. There is a daily towel service and lockers are available on a daily or monthly basis. The Athletic Office, located in the gym, includes the MWR Sports, Fitness and Aquatics programs. The sports program hosts Intramural as well as over 50 Captain's Cup events. Sports include: wallyball, ultimate frisbee, dodgeball, bean bag toss, softball, flag football, golf, tennis, racquetball, basketball, indoor volleyball, sand volleyball, badminton and soccer. Most sports are offered twice a year and there is a fierce competition for the coveted Captain's Cup, awarded annually to the top command.

The gym also offers massages. Patrons can select from a variety of massage types including Swiss, Deep Tissue/Sport as well as other spa services like facial and body treatments. For a complete list of services, visit the Base Gym. For questions or to book a massage, call (904) 542-2930.

Many special events are offered such as the Command Sports Challenge, 5K monthly fun runs and the Annual Navy Run 10K/5K. Visit NavyMWRJacksonville.com to see upcoming special events.

FITNESS CENTER: (904) 542-3518

Located in Bldg. 867 on Enterprise Avenue, this fitness facility has a larger array of cardiovascular and strength equipment compared to the Base Gym. The Fitness Center conducts all fitness classes, has an indoor cycle studio and offers personal training. Lockers and showers are available for daily use in the male and female locker rooms.

The cardio area offers treadmills, stair steppers, step mills, ellipticals, stationary and recumbent bikes. Most of the cardio equipment is connected to a cardio theater which offers a wide array of television channels and radio stations while working out.

There are two separate strength training areas. One is a free weight area which offers Olympic free weights, while the other area offers two complete lines of HOIST ROC-IT and Cybex strength training equipment. Qualified instructors offer a variety of Zumba, indoor cycling, muscle toning, yoga and step classes on select days throughout the week. FAMILY FITNESS CENTER: (904) 778-9772/542-2930

The Family Fitness Center is located above the Youth Center Gym in Bldg. 2069 and provides an environment for promoting healthier lifestyles to the NAS Jacksonville community. The goal of the center is to keep the entire family healthy by providing an environment for families to meet their fitness needs in a family-friendly atmosphere. A qualified fitness instructor will be available to assist patrons with their fitness goals, instruct daily classes and for personal training. The center offers a full circuit of Life Fitness equipment and a safe area for children ages six years and under.

INDOOR POOL: (904) 542-2930

The indoor pool, located inside of the Base Gym on Gillis Road in Bldg. 614, is 50 meters by 25 yards with a graduated depth to 12 feet. The pool has limited lap swim hours of operation for patrons because it is the main training pool for Search and Rescue (SAR) training. Year-round activities include water aerobics, swim lessons, recreational swimming and lifeguard training courses.

OUTDOOR POOL: (904) 542-3720

The outdoor pool, located on Allegheny Road in Bldg. 419, is 50 meters by 25 yards with a graduated depth from 3 - 6 feet. The pool contains a bathhouse, a children's Splash Pad, picnic patio, concession stand and deck, lanes for 25-yard lap swimming, chairs, tables with umbrellas, lounge chairs and a 150-foot water slide. The pool is available for private parties for a fee and are booked on a first come, first served basis.

The pools are free to Active Duty, their dependents, DoD employees, Reservists and Retirees. Sponsored guests are \$3 each. Children 15 years of age and under must be accompanied by, and under the direct supervision of, an individual whose minimum age is 16 years. Children between the ages of 10 and 16 years must pass a swim test to use the facilities.

MCCAFFREY SOFTBALL COMPLEX: (904) 542-2930

The McCaffrey Softball Complex features four playing fields, each with a 275-foot, 16 feet high fence, spectator bleachers, restroom facilities, second floor scorers and announcer's booths for all fields. The complex is utilized in the spring and fall by intramural and greybeard leagues and throughout the year for various tournaments. The McCaffrey Softball Complex also offers a concession stand which serves food, snacks, candy and beverages available for purchase.

TENNIS COMPLEX: (904) 542-2930


The Guy Ballou Tennis Complex is located at the corner of Birmingham Avenue and Allegheny Road. The complex features six lighted and two non-lighted tennis courts, and even two non-lighted, full size basketball courts. No reservations are needed to play.


OUTDOOR RUNNING TRACK: (904) 542-2930

The paved outdoor track is located between Allegheny Road and Biscayne Street. The track is 375 yards and, from the center lane of the track, seven laps are equal to 1.5 miles. The track is used on a first come, first served basis.

SEA KING PARK MULTIPURPOSE FIELD: (904) 542-2930

This multipurpose synthetic field is 350" x 320" and is located at Sea King Park on the corner of Allegheny Road and Birmingham Avenue. This field is equivalent to an NFL field with two flag football fields and one regulation size soccer field. Only players and sports-related items needed to play a sport are permitted on the turf field. The lights are controlled by the Fitness, Sports and Aquatics Department. The turf field can be reserved for a command function or command PT on a first come, first served basis.





COMMUNITY RECREATION









COMMAND EVENT SUPPORT: (904) 542-3681

The Community Recreation Program is proud to support recreational command events aboard NAS Jacksonville. A limited amount of equipment is available at no cost for command events that meet the criteria including tables, chairs, grills and Command Event Trailers that can be delivered to the event site. Each Command Event Trailer comes with twenty tables, one hundred chairs, two bounce houses, two cornhole board sets, two 10' x 10' pop up canopies, ladder ball, two 120 qt. coolers and a sports pack. All equipment is subject to availability.

EQUIPMENT RENTALS: (904) 542-3681

In addition to supporting command functions, Community Recreation also provides equipment rentals for personal use. Items available for rent include tables, chairs, pop up canopy tents, various inflatable equipment such as bounce houses and slides, coolers, a variety of sports equipment and even a dunk tank. All equipment is subject to availability.

LIBERTY CENTER: (904) 542-1335/3491

This high-tech recreation center, located in Bldg. 816, is designed to meet the needs of the E1-E6 Single Sailors and Geographical Bachelors living on board NAS Jacksonville. The Liberty Center contains twenty CAC enabled laptops, a wireless printer, free wireless internet, a movie viewing area, a designated gaming area that consists of the most recent consoles, and a variety of recreational equipment including pool, ping-pong, an outdoor basketball court and more. Everything in the center is open to Active Duty and is free of charge.

The Liberty Center is open 365 days of the year and offers a variety of off base trips to amusement parks, professional sports games, St. Augustine, Daytona Beach, concerts, water parks and more! The Liberty program strives to provide top notch recreational programs with the focus on the development of leisure skills. View the current monthly calendar of events on NavyMWRJacksonville.com.

PARK AND PICNIC AREAS: (904) 542-3111

Several beautiful parks and picnic grounds are scattered around the base. Most are equipped with shelters, restrooms, barbecue pits, ball fields and playground equipment. Reservations are required and can be made up to six months in advance.

MULBERRY COVE MARINA: (904) 542-3260

The Mulberry Cove Marina, located on the south end of Ranger Street along the banks of the beautiful St. Johns River, is a place where patrons can learn to sail, canoe and fish. It offers a wide array of rental equipment including kayaks, canoes, surfboards, stand up paddle boards, fishing kayaks and Flying Scot sailboats. Power boats include pontoon boats, Boston Whalers, 14-foot Trackers and Edgewater center consoles with fish finders. To rent a powerboat, a Florida Safe Boater card is required. The card is available free of charge online at www.boatus.org. Reservations for powerboats must be made in person with a \$25 deposit. Sailing instruction classes and stand up paddle board classes are available March through October.

The Ship's Store carries bait, ice, snacks, a variety of drinks, fishing licenses, fishing tackle, sunglasses, t-shirts, outdoor recreation knives, basic boat parts and various sundries to meet boating needs. The store also has unleaded ethanol-free marine gasoline pier-side and a boat ramp that is free to access.

Slips, moorings and dry storage are available on a daily, monthly and yearly rental basis. Fresh water and 30/50 power is available at the slips. Live-aboards are permitted only on a temporary basis.

FISHING: (904) 542-3260

Fishing is permitted on the north side of Casa Linda Lake (catch and release only) and in the St. Johns River. Fishing is not permitted from the piers at Mulberry Cove Marina. A Florida fishing license is required for anyone ages 15-65. Fishing licenses are available at the marina.

GOLF COURSE AND PRO SHOP: (904) 542-3249

Located in Bldg. 809 on Mustin Road, the NAS Jacksonville Golf Course offers 27 holes of championship golf for people of all ages and skill levels. The Red and White nines are par 36, while the Blue is a par 35. The Red/White course is a demanding 6,890 yards, par 72. The addition of the White nine added to the landscape of the original Red and Blue courses. The holes wind through beautiful tree-lined fairways that are complemented with rich blue lakes. It's one of the finest golf courses in the Jacksonville area and at the top of golfers' playlist. A full practice facility is available, as well as PGA professional staff. Group or private lessons are available by calling the NAS Jax Golf Course Pro Shop.

NAS FREEDOM LANES AND PRO SHOP: (904) 542-3493

The facility is 24-lanes with automatic scoring and automatic bumpers for children. The flooring to the bowling lanes is a flush surface which makes it easily accessible for children and the young at heart. The center offers open bowling, league bowling and Xtreme bowling, a high energy bowling experience with music and lights. The BES X Scoring System allows bowlers to take part in many unique experiences from traditional games to MAD games which are interactive five frame games designed to keep everyone involved and having fun! The Gutterball Grill, a snack bar, is located in the Bowling Center and serves food and beverages daily. Other events include daily specials, summer and winter leagues, intramural leagues, young at heart leagues, command functions and birthday parties. The center also has a pro shop with professional fitting and drilling service. Individual or group lessons are available.





NAVY FLYING CLUB: (904) 542-8509

The Jax Navy Flying Club (JNFC) is located aboard NAS Jacksonville on the north side of the main runway and offers introductory flights, flight instructions and aircraft rentals. The club's focus is to promote general aviation and increased attention to flight safety, while providing a club atmosphere to its members. The JNFC provides pilot training for certifications including: Private Pilot, IFR, Commercial and Instructor ratings. The club offers aircraft rentals for local and overnight cross country flights. The fleet currently includes three single engine low-wing aircraft and the JNFC is constantly looking to increase the number and diversity of aircraft within the club.

SKEET RANGE: (904) 655-9215

Located off Perimeter Road, the Skeet Range is nestled in a secluded area among the trees. Membership eligibility is open to all authorized MWR patrons. Current membership is \$12 per year. Cost for a round of skeet or trap is \$3.50 per round which includes 25 targets. There is an additional charge for ammo.

NAS JAX BINGO: (904) 542-8449

The grand ballroom, located in Dewey's, houses both a lunch and an evening program of bingo. There are daily bingo specials and events throughout the year such as Back to School Bingo, Holiday Bingo, New Year's Day Bingo and much more. Be sure to take advantage of Dewey's full menu selection as you play!



VETERINARY TREATMENT FACILITY: (904) 542-3786

The NAS Jax Veterinary Treatment Facility is managed by the Army Veterinary Service. The clinic offers veterinary preventive services including new puppy/kitten vaccines and health certificates, routine pet immunizations, testing for intestinal parasites/heartworms, medical management of obesity, arthritis, allergies and minor sick call appointments. Routine surgery and dentistry is also available, as well as digital radiology, ultrasound and in-house blood analysis. The VTF also has a well-stocked pharmacy.

Housing residents may keep cats and dogs in their homes, however, all cats and dogs must be registered with the veterinary clinic. All pets staying on base must have proof of current vaccinations, microchipping and spay/neuter presented at the time of registration. Cats and dogs must be on a leash at all times when outdoors unless they are in a fenced-in yard. Veterinary service is available to pets owned by Active Duty and Retired personnel, their dependents and Reservists on active duty. Previous medical documents and vaccination records are required for every pet.



AUTO & STORAGE LOTS





AUTO SKILLS CENTER: (904) 542-3681

The Auto Skills Center is a large, complete auto workshop, located at Bldg. 622 on Birmingham Avenue, that features seven vehicle lifts, fourteen stalls and a motorcycle lift. Customers are issued large rolling tool boxes complete with the tools necessary to perform maintenance on their vehicles. An in-house safety test is mandatory before participation and closed-toe shoes are required while inside the building. For safety reasons, children under the age of 16 are not permitted in or around the facility at any time. An ASE Certified mechanic is onsite to provide advice and perform specific services such as A/C maintenance, brake work and tire balancing. A paint booth is available by appointment. The Auto Skills Center offers female and co-ed Auto Skills 101 classes throughout the year.

DEPLOYED STORAGE: (904) 542-3681

This is a secure lot for vehicles that allows storage from overnight to six months for deployments and for hospitalizations in excess of 30 days.

STORAGE LOT: (904) 542-3681

This gated storage lot has 24-hour access and is available for vehicles, RVs and trailers. Rates are available on a monthly or yearly basis.


AUTORAMA RESALE LOT: (904) 542-3681

The CPO Club is located inside Dewey's restaurant and offers lunch service Monday through Friday from 10:45 a.m. - 1 p.m. After work socials are held Thursdays and all E-7s, E-8s and E-9s, Retirees and their guests are welcome.

GUTTERBALL GRILL: (904) 542-3295

The Gutterball Grill is located in the Bowling Center, Bldg. 609, on Gillis Street. This snack bar serves breakfast, lunch and dinner as well as alcoholic and nonalcoholic beverages daily. The grill offers daily lunch specials; dine-in or take-out is available.
